CLEANING

Regular cleaning of your uPVC windows and doors is required to prevent the build up of everyday grime and atmospheric pollutants to help prolong their life

Please Do

Clean your product with clean soapy water (washing up liquid is suitable) and wipe dry with a soft cloth

Stubborn stains can be removed gently using 'JIF' or 'DECO CLEAN' (available from Weathertight)

Be particularly careful when cleaning products with a woodgrain / colour finish

Ensure drainage slots are kept unblocked and free of dirt and debris (fig 1)

Keep window friction stays (fig 2) and sliding door tracks clear of dust and debris to reduce wear on sliding parts

Glass should be cleaned with soapy water or glass cleaner If using glass cleaner, avoid getting excessive glass cleaner on the uPVC profile

The need for cleaning will vary by position and the environmental conditions in your area
We recommend that your windows and doors should be cleaned at least once every two months


