

UPVC Glazing Instructions

- 1) Remove beads using a broadknife don't mix beads up
- 2) Pack frames as indicated X
 - a) Clip blue lifting wedge into place dark blue 13165 for sliding frames light blue 13106 for all else
 - b) Place yellow packer 13110 on top of bottom lifting wedges
- 3) Fit glass adjust bottom packers so glass is square in opening
- 4) Pack all other lifting wedges to ensure:
 - a) frames are straight
 - b) sashes have equal cover over frames, top to bottom & side to side
 - c) sliding doors are parellel to the frame
 - N.B. heeling & toeing of hinged doors, casement windows, & tilt & turn windows is critical
- 5) Seal vertical packers to prevent them from slipping down
- 6) Replace beads (in the same position they came out of)
 - a) spray glass with glass cleaner to ease fitting
 - b) start with the 2 shortest beads
 - using a rubber mallet as gently as possible tap bead into place starting from the ends & work to the centre
 - c) Spring the 2 longer beads into place & gently tap into place
 - N.B. hitting beads too hard can cause frame welds to crack
- 7) Clean glass







Awning Window







Casement Window












Bi-fold Door
